General Hazards

The most common workplace dangers include trips, falls and slips. Placing or removing things from storage could result in a slip or fumble, possibly resulting in both employee and item to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when employees are moving supplies on various kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common danger is getting hit by falling things. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to incorrect lifting techniques are another common hazard.

There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace machinery. Accidents can normally be caused from the incorrect use of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, such as skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, should be utilized carefully during packing, unpacking and loading.
