Counterbalance forklifts are designed so the weight behind the center of gravity is counterbalanced by the weight on the lift. The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the operator of the forklift. This type of forklift truck should just be utilized on stable, level ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift drivers are needed to obtain training that would enable them to better know the proper or right way across the forklift arms. The trainee will know to properly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. Trainees will know the RTITB standards required for operating the forklift safely. Individuals training would also know the kinds of attachments for the forklift arms.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

Walkie Stackers
