The operation of heavy machine, like cranes, needs safety training. Licensing for crane operators combines specialized training programs and on-the-job supervised work. These training programs are provided by industry training and certification organizations. The content of crane operator training programs may vary depending on the requirements and laws of the local industry.

Certification and training can be offered for different types of cranes, including mobile cranes, overhead cranes, tower cranes and articulator cranes. Overhead cranes are usually used in the manufacturing business. Mobile cranes transport heavy equipment to sites where the job is to be carried out. Articulator cranes are made use of in order to load machinery and materials onto truck beds and other heavy machines. The tower crane are the biggest kind of crane, usually found in large sea ports.

In the manufacturing industry, a crane department supervisor normally has the authority to offer basic hands-on training in safely operating crane machine. Following the practical component, the trainee might need to pass a course. Upon successfully finishing the course, the trainee will be licensed or certified.

Some industrial environments may provide simulated crane operator training, which enables the operator to gain hands-on skills without risk to other employees or equipment. The simulated environment provides a set of virtual activities with a simulated crane, such as realistic controls. By mastering crane operation in simulated training, the operator will have the ability to operate real cranes on the job.

When licensed and certified, crane operators should partake in continuing education in order to regularly upgrade their skills and knowledge. Continuous crane operator training is normally suggested for technicians so they could stay abreast of updates in crane safety features and technology.
